## Grade 3 Supply List 2016-2017

Welcome to Grade 3! We look forward to getting to know you as we work together. Please bring the following supplies with you to Meet Your Teacher on Tuesday, September 6th, 4:00-6:00 pm, or send with your child on the first day of classes if you are unable to attend Meet Your Teacher.

Please **label** the following items:

- \_\_\_ 1 pkg (20-24) Laurentien pencil crayons, sharpened
- \_\_\_ 1 pkg 12 narrow-tipped markers (in basic colors) Laurentien or Crayola
- \_\_\_ 1 pair of scissors (Fiskar brand)
- \_\_\_ 1 Staedler pencil sharpener
- \_\_\_ 1 30 cm plastic ruler
- \_\_\_ 1 blue pen
- \_\_\_ 1 supply container to hold supplies
- \_\_\_ 1 pair of inside/gym shoes\*\*
- \_\_\_ school bag\*\*
- \_\_\_ art t-shirt (any old shirt is fine)\*\*
- \_\_\_ 1 1" binder (not floppy)
- \_\_\_ 4 large white erasers
- \_\_\_ 2 large UHU glue sticks
- \_\_\_ 1-120 ml container of white glue

Please **do NOT** label these items:
