Welcome to Grade 3! We look forward to getting to know you as we work together. Please bring the following supplies with you to Meet Your Teacher on Tuesday, September 5th, 4:00-6:00 pm, or send with your child on the first day of classes if you are unable to attend Meet Your Teacher.

Please **label** the following items:

- ___ 1 pkg (24) Crayola pencil crayons, sharpened
- ___ 1 pkg (12) Crayola fine tipped markers (in basic colours)
- ___ 1 pair of scissors (Fiskar brand)
- ___ 1 Staedler pencil sharpener with container
- ___ 1 sturdy plastic 30 cm ruler (no metal)
- ___ 1 blue pen (from home)
- ___ 2 small supply containers to hold supplies
- ___ 1 1" binder (not floppy)
- ___ 4 large white erasers
- ___ 2 large UHU glue sticks
- ___ 1 120 ml container of white glue
- ___ 1 pair of earbuds (from home)
- ___ 1 pair of inside/gym shoes**
- ___ school bag**
- ___ art t-shirt (any old shirt is fine)**

Please do NOT label these items:

- ___ 1 package of 3"x3" square sticky notes
- ___ 2 boxes of Kleenex
- ___ 4 duotangs with pockets (light blue, red, green, yellow)
- ___ 1 package of dividers (5 tab)
- ___ 2 folders with pockets (not plastic)

We will also be collecting \$3.50 per student to cover the cost of whiteboard markers. In the past, we have asked students to bring 4 dry erase markers. This item is \$6.49 plus tax from Staples. If we buy in bulk we can decrease the cost to each student.
